Finance Report:

The financial state of the Home Association continues to look much better. A Financial Report was submitted by Nikki Valle, GM and Missy Zimmerman, Asst Manager.

Donation to the Legion for June 2024 was \$14,094.00

The motion to donate \$14,094.00 to the Legion was made by Richard Crumlich and seconded by Adrienne O'Brien. Motion carried.

Pay the Sons Membership dues through June 30th, 2024, of \$11,280.00. Motion made by Greg Snyder and seconded by John Godshall. Motion carried.

Motion by Adrienne O'Brien and second by Greg Snyder to accept the Finance Report as presented. Motion carried.

Staffing:

Discussed Jade returning to work for the Legion. The motion was made not to rehire Jade was made by Larry Oakes and seconded by Greg Snyder. Motion carried.

Nikki would like to hire a part-time server at \$7.25. She is willing to work flexible hours. Motion made by Adrienne O'Brien and seconded by John Godshall. Motion carried

Membership:

- New members will be voted on during the general membership meeting at 7pm.

Old Business:

Motion by Adrienne O'Brien and second by John Gutshall for the Home Association to keep 100% of the Skill Machine revenue along with the five months of arrears payments until the Home Association is able to get all

of the arrear's payments to the Legion. This will be re-looked at once all payments have been made. Motion passed.

It was brought to Nikki's attention by the LCE that we cannot cap the Daily Book at \$2500 and start another book. The same is true for the Weekly Book. This is illegal per the LCE Laws because we have more than one book going, and the law only allows for one book. After discussion it was decided to cap the Daily Book at \$3500 and the weekly at \$5000. On the evening that the book reaches \$3500 or \$5000 there will be a drawing held until there is a winner. Motion made for the above by Kathy Killinger and seconded by John Gutshall. Motion carried.

Health benefits set to 30% paid by full time employees. (Robert, Garry, Janel and Nikki V) Motion made by John Godshall and seconded by Greg Snyder motion carried.

New Business:

Discussion on the Preventative Maintenance of the 5 coolers in the Canteen. Peak Cooling Offered to perform a PM on the 5 coolers for \$175. A motion was made to have it done every 6 months with a total of \$350. Motion by Greg Snyder and seconded by Adrienne O'Brien motion carried.

Adrienne O'Brien requested to open an Uber account of \$200. It would be used to transport intoxicated patrons home safely. Motion by Richard Crumlich seconded by Kathy Killinger motion carried.

Nikki Valle brought up the idea to have a Legion family shirt to sell. The setup is approx. \$225 and costs per shirt \$10-12. We can sell the shirts for \$20/25 depending on the size. Nikki will follow up with pricing.
